



NATIONAL CERTIFICATION ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA FOR TEACHERS AND OTHER PROFESSIONAL EMPLOYEES

There are different levels of salary supplement available for employees who have achieved national certification from their respective organizations. Please determine which category you fall into to determine what supplement you should be receiving

Eligibility Criteria	Supplement amount
Educators who received Certification from the National Board for Professional Teaching Standards on or before May 21, 2008 AND have continuously maintained their certification during this timeframe.	12% of the STATE portion of salary
Educators or other professionals who have received the following certifications on or before May 21, 2008 AND have continuously maintained their certification during this timeframe: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ○ Certificate of clinical competence—speech pathologists and audiologists (ASHA); ○ Nationally certified school counselor (NBCC); ○ Music therapist—Board certified (CBMT); ○ Nationally certified school psychologist (NASP); and ○ Nationally certified school nurse (NBCSN). 	6% of the STATE portion of salary
Educators who received Certification from the National Board for Professional Teaching Standards after May 21, 2008 or whose certification has lapsed but is now current.	\$2,000 annually
Educators or other professionals who have received the following certifications after May 21, 2008 or whose certification has lapsed but is now current: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ○ Certificate of clinical competence—speech pathologists and audiologists (ASHA); ○ Nationally certified school counselor (NBCC); ○ Music therapist—Board certified (CBMT); ○ Nationally certified school psychologist (NASP); and ○ Nationally certified school nurse (NBCSN). 	\$2,000 annually
